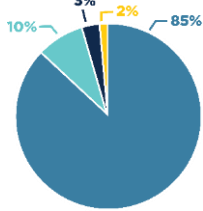

The gifts to the Annie Armstrong Easter Offering are used to train and resource missionaries in church planting and compassion ministries. Gifts are also used to create evangelism resources. Because of your generous and sacrificial gifts, almost 3,000 missionaries across North America receive support. Because of this, Southern Baptist churches have planted more than 10,000 churches in North America since 2010.
